PRESS STATEMENT

Monday, 31 July 2023, Monrovia: The National Elections Commission (NEC), in collaboration with the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS) and the United Nations (UN) will on Wednesday, 2 August 2023, hold a briefing with Presidential Aspirants for the 2023 Electoral Process.

The briefing is a reaffirmation of the Board of Commissioners' pledge and determination to apply all of the best practices to ensure a peaceful electoral process and further deepen the understanding of the aspirants about ongoing preparations for the election.

The event is a part of the Electoral Management Body's ongoing dialogue with stakeholders to promote inclusive, credible, peaceful, and non-violent elections, as enshrined in the Farmington River Declaration recently signed by registered political parties and independent aspirants.

The engagement will address the basic information that all aspirants, supporters, and voters must conduct themselves in a peaceful and non-violent manner before, during, and after the elections.

It will allow the NEC to interact with the aspirants and solicit their commitment to a peaceful and non-violent electoral process.

Meanwhile, the Commission has released the final voter registration data per electoral district and voting precincts on its website (necliberia.org).
