Monrovia, 21 April 2023 (NEC): The National Elections Commission (NEC) has released the preliminary disaggregated statistics of the just-ended Phase One voter registration exercise for Bomi, Gbarpolu, Grand Bassa, Grand Cape Mount, Margibi, and Montserrado Counties.

NEC announces a preliminary register containing 1,435,209 eligible voters with 711,410 females and 723,799 males in the six counties of phase one. A unique feature of the preliminary register is that Montserrado and Margibi counties recorded slightly higher numbers of females than males. In Margibi, 92,438 females registered as opposed to 91,987 males, while in Montserrado, 446,936 females were recorded and 444,265 males.

The Commission informs the public that it will upload the statistics per county, gender, and the number of registered voters per electoral district in the six Phase One counties on its website (<https://www.necliberia.org>). The commission will also publish data per registration centers in the coming days.

Meanwhile, the second phase of biometric voter registration will commence today, 21 April 2023 in Bong, Lofa, Nimba, Grand Gedeh, River Gee, Maryland, Grand Kru, Sinoe, and Rivercess Counties.

NEC calls on all Liberians 18 years and above living in these counties to register in order to vote in the 10 October 2023 Presidential and Legislative elections.

NEC warns that it is a crime to register or attempt to register more than once and that the voter information of those involve will be deactivated.
